Description of Position:

The Chaplain is responsible for the administration and facilitation of religious/spiritual programming in a correctional setting. This includes coordinating religious services, providing spiritual care for inmates regardless of their faith tradition, recruiting and supervising religious volunteers for all faiths. Benefits include standard state employee package plus annual housing allowance as a tax deduction and up to 40 hours annual administrative leave relative to endorsement and/or job performance enhancement.

Minimum Qualifications:

- ***Bachelor's degree** in theology, religion, psychology, sociology or closely related field
- ***Endorsement** from candidate's religious body
- ***Two years full time (FT), salaried experience** managing religious programming (indicate FT status on resume). Prior chaplaincy experience, prison/jail ministry, inter-faith work, and Clinical Pastoral Education (C.P.E.) training are desirable. Ability to practice professional religious program management in a multi-faith setting is essential. Administrative, planning, supervision and counseling skills are required.
