INTERVENTION FEE

Under Missouri law, all persons under supervision are required to pay a monthly fee of \$30.00, due the 1st of each month. Payments must be made by money order and mailed with the invoice provided by your supervising officer, at payment kiosks located at your probation and parole office or online at:
