

DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Alt-Care: Intensive substance abuse treatment for female offenders who have demonstrated a need for treatment and related supportive services. This program uses a therapeutic community approach.

BASES: Day report program including substance abuse education, employment, cognitive restructuring and life skills.

Community Partnership for Restoration (CPR): Intensive supervision program for male offenders including substance abuse treatment, cognitive restructuring and reparation boards (parolees residing in St. Louis City or probationers sentenced in St. Louis City only).

Gang CPR: Intensive supervision caseload designed for early intervention and close monitoring of documented male gang members sentenced to probation in St. Louis City. Clients have access to all services available to other CPR clients as well as additional programming/life skills services.

Domestic Violence Unit: Intensive supervision of domestic violence offenders enrolled in batterer's intervention services. Designed to deter unlawful victim contact and future victimization.

Free and Clean: Intensive outpatient substance abuse treatment for offenders who have completed 120-day institutional treatment or long-term institutional treatment. Probationers or parolees who reside inside the I-270 loop.

MERS/Schirmer House: Residential facilities for female offenders including comprehensive case management services.
