

**Farmington Community  
Supervision Center:**

Community Supervision Centers (CSC) are residential facilities which provide community-based transitional services and supervision strategies to clients released from the Division of Adult Institutions as well as clients under community supervision who are in need of additional structure or treatment support. Services at these facilities may include substance abuse assessment, treatment, counseling, employment, educational, and housing assistance, and links to other community-based resources and services.

While in the CSC, residents will progress through 4 phases, each with a set of goals. These goals include completing programming, maintaining a sober lifestyle, gaining financial stability, obtaining employment, and any other goals set by the client and their Probation and Parole Officer.

The ORAS is an assessment system that determines offenders' risk to re-offend by looking at their criminogenic needs.

Assessment outcomes aid in creating an individualized plan for supervision, which enhances offender success.




### Programming

Programming is a key aspect of a client's success in the CSC and their reentry into the community. Each client's programming needs are determined by their ORAS domain scores, with areas of high and moderate risk being the main focus.

The CSC offers a wide variety of evidence-based programming and treatment facilitated by both staff and community partners.

## Available Programming:

- ◆ Career Readiness: Skills to Succeed, Seeking Employment, Skills to Pay the Bills
- ◆ Life Skills: Restorative Justice
- ◆ Cognitive: Decision Points, Family Ties, Getting Started, Peer Relationships, Responsible Thinking, Self-Control, Social Values, Substance Use



- ⇒ Adult Education/HiSET classes through UniTec
- ⇒ Substance Use and Mental and Behavioral Health treatment through Southeast Missouri Behavioral Health
- ⇒ Conquering Addiction outreach program through The Bridge Community Church
