Offenders Offering Alternatives: An educational session and guided tour of a correctional facility conducted by inmates. Emphasis is on the loss of freedom along with group discussion on lifestyle, choices, and alternatives to criminal behavior. Contact supervising office for referral.

Pathway to Change: A cognitive behavior development program designed to help offenders change their behavior by offering insight into the decision making process. It increases cognitive skills through value based lesson plans.
