

DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Improving Community Treatment Services (ICTS)

Formerly known as the JRI program within Pettis County. This program provides wrap around services to Missourians involved in the criminal justice system with the tools they need to stay out of prison.

Victim Impact Panel

Allow offenders to hear a panel of speakers provide information and first-hand experience regarding how crimes impact the victims, families and communities. This program is sponsored by the local Citizens Advisory Board (CAB).

Drug Court Program

Program available in Pettis and Cooper County, with a total potential caseload of 50 offenders.

Offenders Offering Alternatives

Designed for offender's to spend a day within a Department of Corrections Institution. Conducted b offenders currently incarcerated, this program will afford the opportunity to provide the realities of prison life. Tours are prearranged. Clients must arrange their own transportation.

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

MRP Steering Team

This grass roots team of service providers, law enforcement personnel, corrections staff and local citizens meets to coordinate delivery of services to offenders, with a specific focus on enhancing the smooth re-entry of offenders from correctional institutions to the community on a monthly basis.

Sex Offender Treatment

All persons convicted of sex offenses must undergo a regimented and approved program of treatment, as a part of their supervision in the community. Staff oversee the delivery of treatment services, working closely with the treatment provider, to assist with offender rehabilitation.

Substance Abuse Treatment

Substance abuse in the offender population is a serious and pervasive problem. Staff in D29 join with treatment professionals to monitor offender alcohol and drug problems, with effective treatment and eventual recovery as expected goals.
