

## DISTRICT PROGRAMS

District 8-Central runs a number of programs to assist clients. These include:

### **Drug Court**

A voluntary treatment program providing intensive community supervision for nonviolent drug and alcohol offenders, including probationers in violation status and first-time offenders with a drug history.

### **DWI Court**

A voluntary treatment program providing intensive community supervision for nonviolent alcohol offenders, including probationers in violation status and first-time offenders with a history of alcohol related and DWI charges.

### **Mental Health Court**

A voluntary treatment program providing intensive community supervision for nonviolent offenders who are suffering from mental health illness, including probationers in violation status and first-time offenders that may also have a drug and/or alcohol history.

### **Veterans Treatment Court**

A voluntary treatment program providing intensive community supervision for nonviolent drug and alcohol offenders who are veterans, including probationers in violation status and first-time offenders that may have a drug use history and/or mental illness, or drug/DWI charges.

### **Electronic Monitoring**

Electronic Monitoring (EM), a home based strategy, enhances supervision through the use of various Electronic Monitoring devices including RF, GPS and alcohol monitoring.

### **Substance Misuse Education**

An 8-week substance misuse education program on Tuesday 5:30 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.
